A number of Palaeolithic statuettes and engravings depicting female creatures have been discovered in Italy. Most of them belong to the Gravettian, but other ones are of Lateglacial age. The corpus of the Italian female representations will be presented, and compared with similar works of art discovered over the Alps. Comparisons will also be made with male depictions in the Italian Palaeolithic record.
